- Certified copy of related training.
- If a language other than the listed South African languages a certified copy from the Embassy concerned.
- Certified copy of a current first Aid certificate at level one for 3-years.
- Certified copies of related training.
- Certified copies of Education standards achieved.
- Certified copy of In-date Divemaster Certificate or Scuba diving Instructor Status.
- Certified copies of Indemnity Insurances.
- Certified copies of PDP if driver guide.
- Submit R240 for registration with the Provincial Tourism Board.
- Certified copy of a certificate as proof of your membership to the local tourism office.

Once assessed, moderated by AQN and confirmed as COMPLIANT, you will be able to register with your Provinces Tourism board and be legal with a temporary permit until THETA has verified.

The statutory level one guide unit standard TG 01 for Underwater Marine and Shark Diving Guides has been pushed up to level four. It is the same format but assessed at a much higher level.
